### Board of Directors Meeting

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2024 VIA ZOOM

**BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT:** David Dyer, Ed Ricker, Simon Willcox, Tony Blanchard, Jeff Beuttell, John Thibault and Spike Enck.

#### CALL TO ORDER: 5:39PM

**Board Meeting Minutes:** David called for approval of the submitted board meeting minutes for July 10, 2024. The minutes were approved as submitted.

**Treasurer's Report:** Ed reviewed August 2024 financial statement. He reported 48 paid active members as of the end of August 2024. A correction was made regarding junior members for 2024, currently the club has 2 junior members. It was discussed and confirmed that junior members need to submit a signed application and waiver form each year to be considered an active member. The August 2024 financial statement was approved as submitted.

Secretary's Report: There was no secretary's report.

#### OLD BUSINESS

**Club House Maintenance:** Leveling of the structure was discussed. Elliot has put forth a plan that to do so that would require a tractor with loader forks to lift the structure. A tractor is available as is a <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ton truck to haul but we need to rent a trailer. Trailer rental was discussed and approved. Elliot shall be scheduling a work party and recruiting volunteers. It was suggested other maintenance tasks be discussed as a separate task and workday from the structure leveling effort.

**SCMS Software:** Simon will put together a slide deck outlining the pros and cons of using the software and present to the board at October 2024 meeting.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

**2025 Club Officers** (Spike): A list of nominees shall be presented for approval at the October 2024 meeting. Approved listing of nominees shall be sent to all active members at least 10 days prior to the November 2024 meeting for the purpose of voting

**Fall Float Fly:** Peter Pappas shall again bring his boat for plane recovery. All members urged to participate and support the event.

**2025 Dues:** Discussed and decided there will be no change to the club dues for 2025.

**Member Promotion:** David Dyer raised the topic of attracting new members to the club. John Thibault spoke about the problem, and its effect across all aspects of RC modeling. Reviewed the AMA material he has read and the suggestions they propose. John volunteered to further investigate ideas for collaborating with other RC faction clubs to help each other raise the membership numbers. There was a suggestion to open a dialog with the hobby shop to promote the purchase of hobby products locally and determine how the shop and club can work together to promote the hobby.

### ACE Camp Day a Success

The Maine ACE Camp is a day camp in which youngsters between 12 and 16 are introduced to many different aspects of aviation. They learn through classroom instruction, hands on activities and field trips. ACE stands for Aviation Career Education. ACE Camps are co-sponsored by the FAA along with many other organizations.

The Propsnappers have volunteered their time and buddy-boxes to the ACE Camp program for many seasons now, most recently on August 1 when Bill Lairsey, Spike Enck and David Dyer welcomed about a dozen campers to our field and provided a taste of what model aviation is all about.

### saturday, september 28 at 8:30am Volunteers Needed for Clubhouse Project -



Over the past couple of seasons, it has come to our attention that our beloved clubhouse is slowly sinking due to its placement atop a capped landfill. We have been monitoring it carefully, and have decided that it's finally time to take some corrective measures.

Spearheaded by Elliott Randall, and with the valuable assistance of Simon Wilcox, there is a work party scheduled for Saturday, September 28 to carefully lift a corner of the structure, reinforce the foundation platform and place multiple patio blocks underneath to bring things back into plumb. Materials have been delivered and we have arranged for the rental of the proper equipment to make things happen. However, we are looking for volunteers to help with the project.

Elliott is hoping that folks can assemble at the field at 8:30AM on that Saturday and be ready to lend a hand. Bring work gloves and any beverages or snacks you might need to keep you going. Many hands will make the project go quickly (and smoothly), so it is anticipated that we will be done in a couple hours.

If Mother Nature does not cooperate, the project will be shifted to the next day...Sunday, September 29.

#### WHEN ARE YOU FLYING? A Great Tool to Connect Members

This season, several more Propsnappers adopted the *WhatsApp Messenger* phone application to let others know when they

are going to the field. Most users have found the tool



to be quite helpful. The app is free to download from the Google Play Store for Android and the App Store for iPhones.

Members are notified when someone else in the group leaves a note. Messages identify the sender and the day/time that the note was posted. Only invited members belonging to the group will see your message or can respond. It's easy to use and a great way to stay informed about who is flying and when.

#### JUST A REMINDER Entrance Gate Procedure

**MONDAY THRU FRIDAY** - We are permitted to keep the gate swung open while we are flying from 8:00AM to 4:00PM. Last one out closes and locks the gate.

**ON WEEKENDS** - The gate must be swung closed but left unlocked by putting the chain over the gate.

In either situation, make sure the padlock itself <u>is locked</u> on the chain so it does not disappear. Thanks!
